Outline to improve PE provision at SSSJ:

- * Hire specialist PE coaches to teach a full and wide PE curriculum, based on the new national curriculum guidelines, alongside our staff, as a valuable staff training programme.
- * Teach children all the essential skills they need - to be able to take part in competitive sports and games - in each area of the PE curriculum (particularly focussing on gymnastics).
- * Train teaching staff and help them become more confident and knowledgeable in teaching PE.
- * Trial a new PE scheme in year 3 and train a member of staff in Key Stage 1 by sending them on a course based on this PE scheme to trial the scheme later on in the year.
- * Cater to the most gifted and talented children at our school. Each week, Tim Rees holds an after school club for the most talented children in Key Stage two, in both football and cricket, with the view to coaching them in smaller groups, ready to take part in more school tournaments.
- * Run internal and external sports competitions. Each Friday, children will take part in fun tournaments, covering a range of sports and games.
- * Hold sports days across school.
- * Run a wide range of sporting extra-curricular activities. This year we will have various sporting clubs such as: dodgeball, dance and fitness, rugby, multi-skills, football, rounders, hockey and cricket.
