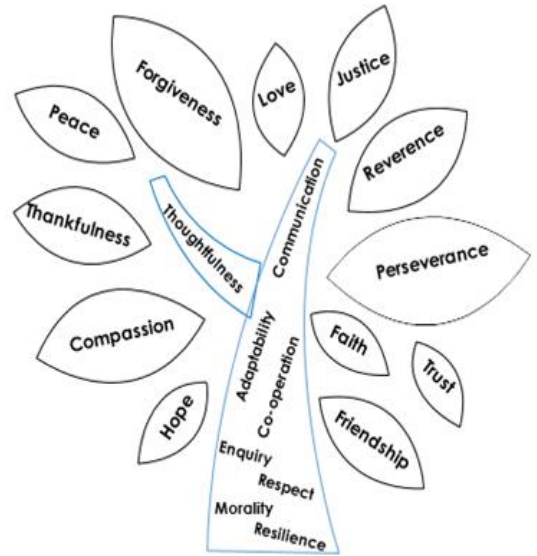
## Spotlight on learning

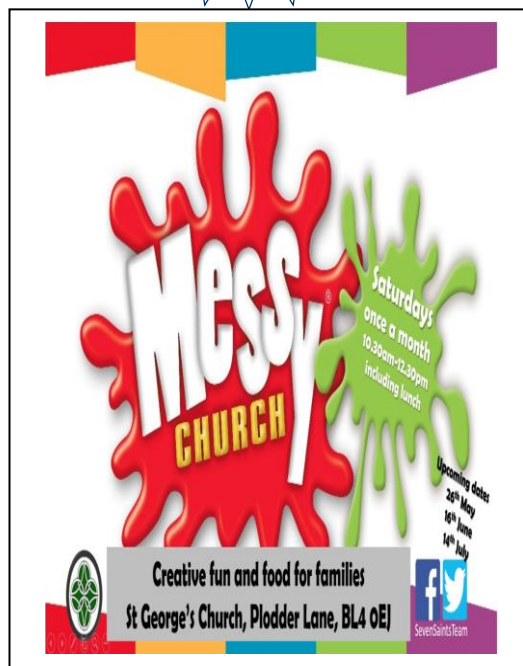
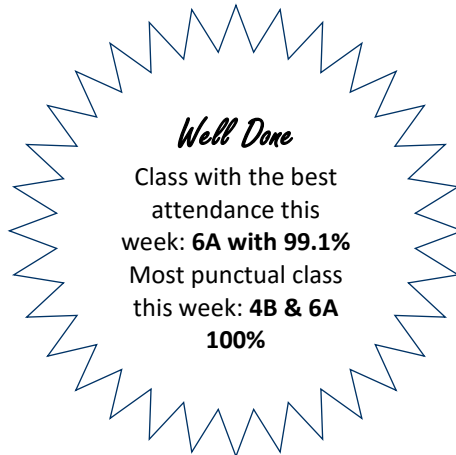
## Hot Days!
