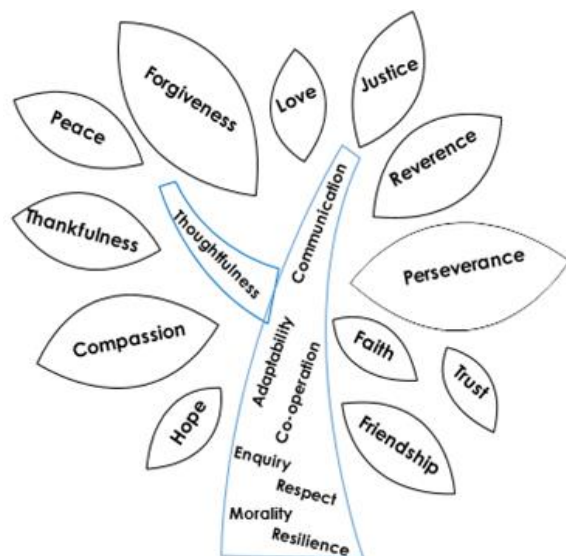


Spotlight on learning
