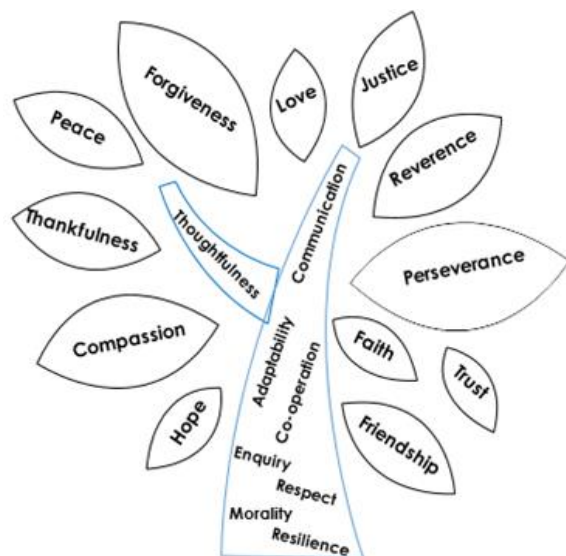


## Spotlight on learning
