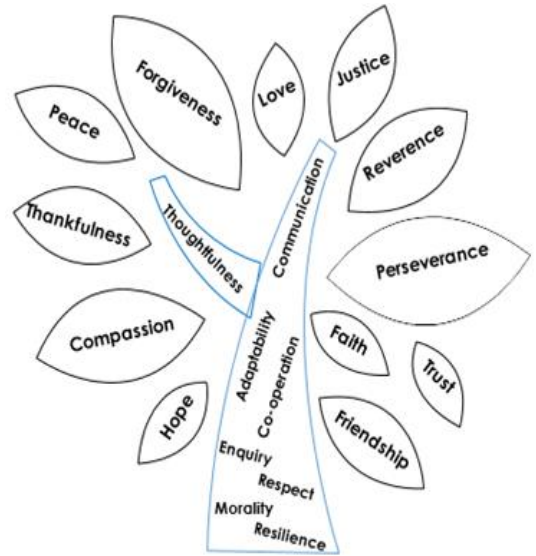
## Spotlight on learning
