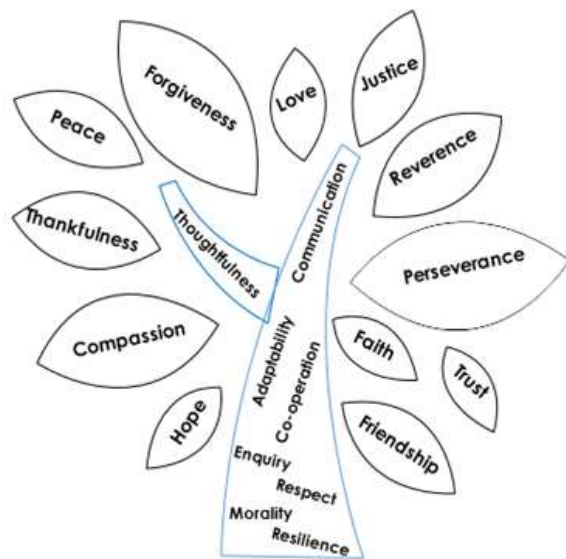


Spotlight on learning

School Absences

From 1st September 2018, the criteria for issuing a penalty notice reduced. A fine will be considered where a pupil has had 10 sessions (equivalent of five days - consecutive or otherwise) of unauthorised absence over the period of two consecutive half terms and may even be taken off role. If a child is off with an illness a doctor's letter **must** be provided after the 3rd day of sickness, otherwise this will be classed as an unauthorised absence.

We do not authorise any school holidays regardless of the circumstances.
