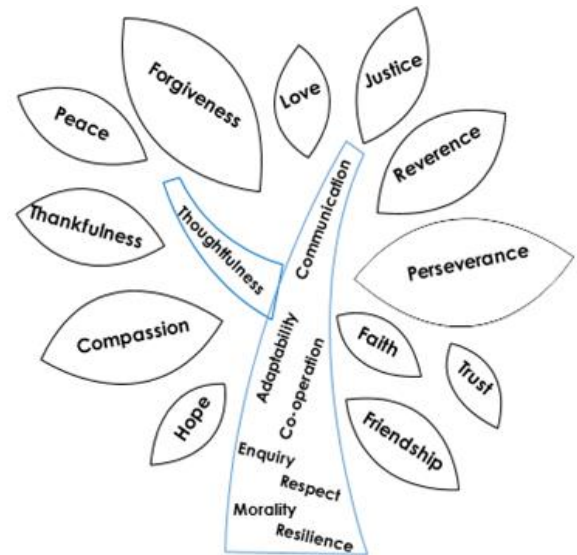
Spotlight on learning
