

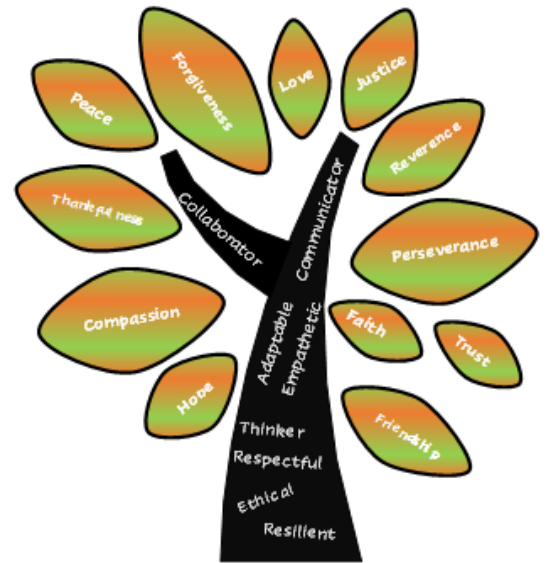
SSSJ School Newsletter
