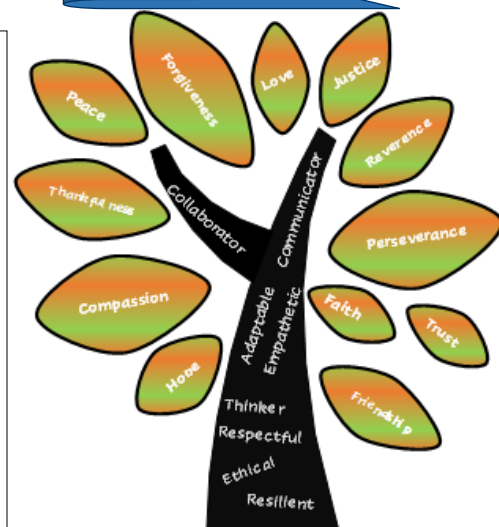


Secondary school applications for 2022 need to be submitted by **Sunday 31st October 2021**. Please use the website provided if you have not already submitted your application.
