This event is free of charge to our school, but in order to continue this fantastic work in the future, they rely on selling merchandise such as badges and magnets. These are priced at £1. The first aid training is taking place on Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> May and Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> May.

Pupils from **Year 1 to Year 4** will be trained in basic first aid on **Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> May**. **Each pupil will need to bring in a teddy from home in order to practice CPR.**

Pupils in **Year 5 and Year 6** will be trained in basic first aid on **Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> May**. Each pupil in these year groups will be given the opportunity to practice CPR on a manikin.
