REVERENCE
When you show reverence, you show deep respect for someone or something. We understand that we are all special, and we celebrate our differences. Reverence is a core value within our school as it is the foundation stone of relationships within our community. We learn to value ourselves, each other and the wider community through honesty, tolerance and trust where everyone has equal right to our time and attention.

This week in worship we have discussed a new team being employed at Blackpool zoo to stop seagulls stealing food from visitors and other animals. We have explored the key question 'Are some animals pests?'. The children commented on what animals they liked and disliked.

At home talk to your children about treating all animals with respect even if sometimes we need to protect ourselves and others from certain animals.

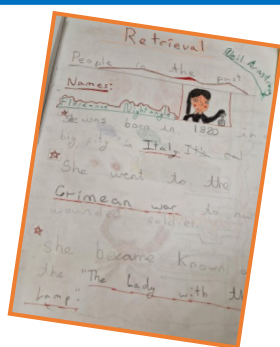
Spotlight on learning - Year 5 and 6 Cricket tournament

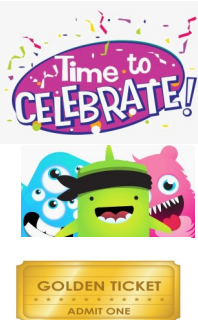
