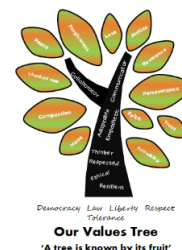




SSSJ School Newsletter

FAITH

At SSSJ, we believe that faith is our firm foundation on which everything else is built upon. We are rooted in our faith in God but also in faith, trust and confidence in ourselves, others and in the children we teach. We encourage children to develop faith in themselves and develop core beliefs to equip them as they leave our school and step out into the world.

This week in worship we have discussed that maybe in 10 years the travel time between London and Sydney will be around 2 hours via spacecrafts instead of the usual 20/22 hours via a plane. We have explored the key questions such as 'Do you enjoy travelling?' 'What mode of transport do you prefer?' The children then discussed where they would like to go traveling, why and who with.

At home talk to your children about the evolution of transport of the world and how technology has helped shaped the transport we know and use today.

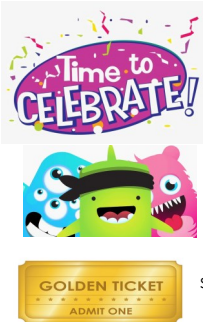


Term Dates
