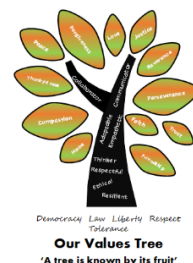

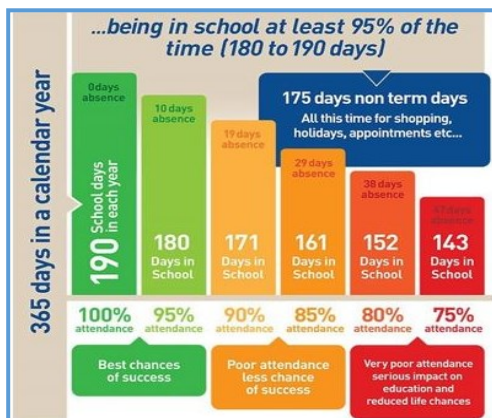
School finishes on Friday 16th February and will resume Monday 26th February

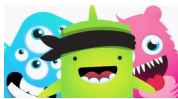
